

Cheerful Critters Pull Up Graduation Card  
May 2015



Supplies:

Stamps: Fabulous Four 134174, Cheerful Critters 137932, Celebrate Today 137138  
Ink: Tuxedo Black Memento Ink 132708, Garden Green Stampin' Write Marker, Blushing Bride Stampin' Write Marker 131265  
Paper: Basic Black CS 121045, Whisper White CS 100730, Garden Green CS 102584, Silver Glimmer Paper 135314  
Big Shot: Balloon Framelits Dies 137362, MiniTreat Bag Thinlits (stars) 137547, Organza Ribbon 114319, 1/8" Circle punch 134365, 1" Circle punch 119868

Measurements:

Basic Black 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"  
Garden Green 3-1/2" x 4-3/4", 3" x 3-1/4", scrap for stars  
Whisper White 3-1/4" x 4-5/8", 2-3/4" x 3", 1-3/4" x 3-1/2"

1. Cut a slit, 3" from the bottom and starting 3/4" from the fold to 3/4" before the card edge, on the front panel of the Black card base

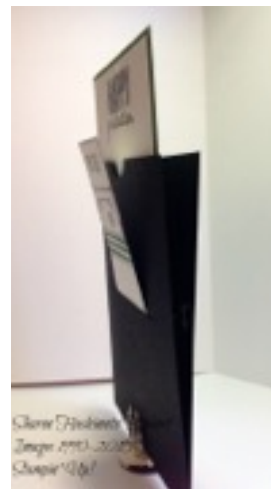
2. Stamp "Happy Graduation" on the 3-1/4" x 4-5/8" WhisperWhite CS. Attach to the Garden Green CS (3-1/2" x 4-3/4").



3. Stamp the bear from Cheerful Critters on the 1-3/4" x 3-1/2" Whisper White CS. Place the top of the sign close to the edge of the paper. Trim away the excess Whisper White CS around the bear. Color in the bear as desired.



4. Attach the bear to the bottom of the Happy Graduation piece as shown in the photo. Feed the bear piece through the slit in the front of the Basic Black card base.



5. Using the 1" punch cut a half circle at the top of the black card base. Use glue or another thin adhesive to close the card up. Be sure to not get any glue on the Garden Green piece or your card will not pull up. Tie a knot with the Organza ribbon to the top of the Garden Green piece. This is what you will use to pull the bear piece up and down
