

Timeless Tropical & the Many Medallions Die

Stampin' Up! Supplies:

- STAMPS -Timeless Tropical (151497)
- PAPER -Thick Whisper White (140272), Magenta Madness (153080), Basic Black (121045), Shimmery White (101910), Sparkle Glimmer Paper (146957)
- INK - Versamark (102283), Melon Mambo Ink Refill (115662), Granny Apple Green Ink Refill (147163), Daffodil Delight Ink Refill (119672)
- OTHER - In the Tropics Dies (151495), Many Medallions Dies (153584), White Stampin' Emboss Powder (109132), Heat Tool (129053), Aqua Painter (103954), Fun Foam (craft supply store)

Cutting & Scoring:

- Thick Whisper White - 11" x 4-1/4" card base score & fold at 5-1/2"
- Magenta Madness - 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- Basic Black- 4-1/4" x 5-1/2"
- Shimmery White 3" x 4-3/4"
- Sparkle Glimmer Paper 1" x 2"

Instructions:

- Adhere the Magenta Madness cardstock to the Whisper White card base.
- Use the large Many Medallions die and Black cardstock and cut die using a die cut machine
- Use dots of glue to attach the Basic Black die cut to the Magenta Madness cardstock
- Stamp the hibiscus and 2 leaves from the Timeless Tropical stamp set with Versamark ink on Shimmery White CS. Sprinkle white embossing powder over the image and shake off the excess, Heat emboss using the Heat Tool
- Use the Aqua Painter and wet down a petal of the flower. Use the Aqua Painter and pick up some ink (Melon Mambo ink refill) and touch it to the petal. The water on the petal should help to move the ink. Help the process by adding water as needed and moving the water and ink with the Aqua Painter. Repeat to color the hibiscus. Add Daffodil Delight to the stigma. Repeat the process using Granny Apple Green ink on the leaves.
- Cut the hibiscus and leaves out using the In the Tropics dies

- Cut the aloha die out of Sparkle Glimmer Paper. Repeat and cut out the aloha die from a piece of fun foam.
- Adhere the Sparkle Glimmer aloha to the fun foam using glue.
- Attach the hibiscus and leaves to the front of the card using dimensional
- Attach aloha to the card front using glue.
